Creation to Nations	God created everything and it was very good. He created human beings in his own image and made them co-regents of his creation to create and cultivate as He does. He gave them a free will to choose and the ability to love.	God warned the man and woman to eat from every tree in the garden, but not from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. When Adam and Eve chose to disobey God, they died spiritually (broke their relationship with God) and began to die physically.	Generations of mankind continued in rebellion against God and the natural consequence was wickedness and brokenness. God graciously saves Noah and his family and provides a "restart" for humanity. Noah and family exited the ark and sinned again.	The nations grew in their defiance of God and built a symbol of their self-reliance and rebellion. Rather than putting God at the center, they produced an imitation. God scatters mankind by confusing their language.
Abraham to Land	God chooses Abraham and his family to be the instruments. Abraham, his son Isaac, Isaac's son, Jacob and Jacobs 12 sons become the 12 tribes of Israel. They are saved when Joseph forgives his brothers and brings them to Egypt.	Israel becomes slaves in Egypt and God raises up Moses to deliver them. God brings them out of Egypt, across the Red Sea, gives them the Law and lives among them as symbolized in the Tabernacle.	After disobeying God's direction and ignoring his promises, the children of Israel wander around in the wilderness for 40 years until a new generation rises. The new gen. is just like the old one, but God keeps his promises to them.	God uses Joshua to lead the Israelites across the Jordan River and into the promised land. They defeat Jericho and other enemies of God in the land.
Judges to Judgment	Judges: T - they Turn away from God, U- under the oppression of enemies, R-repent and turn back to God, N-God sends them a New Leader. The cycle continues. Everyone did what was right in his own eyes, but ignored God, their King.	Kings: God granted Israel a King: Saul, David, Solomon. Because of Israel's sin, the Kingdom is split North and South. 10 Tribes in the North and 2 Tribes in the South.	Exile: After repeated warnings from the Prophets, the Israelites are judged for their sin. The Northern Tribes are taken by Assyria in 722 BC and scattered. The Southern Tribes are taken by Babylon in 586 BC and exiled to Babylon.	Return from Exile: God miraculously brought Israel back to their land. They rebuilt the Temple (Ezra) and the Wall around Jerusalem (Nehemiah).
