
8-10 construction workers with experience to work alongside our long-supported missionaries, Scott and Susie Hampton

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS:

- Maximum team size is 10 individuals

ALL APPLICANTS:

- Must know Jesus as Savior, have a mature and growing faith, be responsible, flexible and have a servant attitude.
- Must be age 18 or older, as of Jan 19, 2019.
- Must be personable and work well with a team.
- Must have personal health insurance.

COST & EXPENSES:

- \$750/person (Includes registration fees, flight, lodging, meals, add'l travel costs and ministry expenses for the team)

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must complete an application form. (Due by Sept 23)
- Must complete all KidSafe certification requirements.
- Once approved, a \$50 registration fee is required to hold your place on the team.
- Team Members must attend all training meetings.
- Must be willing to raise personal support.

PROCESS:

- After initial contact, fill out an application form.
- Submit the completed form to Austin in the church office no later than respective deadline.
- All materials will be reviewed before anyone is confirmed as a team member.
