(includes lodging, meals, travel costs, and ministry expenses)



Why Northern Ireland?

We will primarily minister in Rathfriland. This small village has in-vited us to come and reach the voung people in their area. We will seek to build relationships and share the gospel with children, teens and adults. Email and Facebook will allow us to stay in touch with many of the teens we meet. We will meet with the Director of Youth Ministry for all of Northern Ireland to learn about the political and religious prejudice and the unrest that has defined the people of Northern Ireland for hundreds of years. We have the distinct advantage to enter the lives of the Irish as Americans, not as protestants or catholics, which gives us a great opportunity for the gospel.
